 - **Compreensão:** Consegue entender os pontos principais de uma linguagem clara e padrão sobre assuntos familiares, encontrados no trabalho, na escola ou em momentos de lazer.
 - **Conversação:** Consegue lidar com a maioria das situações que podem surgir durante uma viagem a um país de língua inglesa.
 - **Escrita:** É capaz de produzir textos simples e conectados sobre temas familiares ou de interesse pessoal.
 - **Vocabulário:** Um nível B1 geralmente envolve um vocabulário de cerca de 2.500 a 3.000 palavras.
 - **Gramática:** Consegue usar estruturas gramaticais básicas com precisão e compreender estruturas mais complexas.

- **Fluência em situações cotidianas:** Consegue lidar com a maioria das situações do dia a dia e manter conversas básicas.
